

Braymer vs. Hamilton

The Braymer Bobcats fell to 1-2 losing 37-7 to the Hamilton Hornets Friday night. The Hornets struck first 7-0 with a long run from Trevor Dixon. The defenses held up for both sides the first couple series as Hamilton and Braymer went three and out in both of their first offensive series. Hamilton broke for every score on long runs as Braymer let up big runs for a score all night.

The week three player of the week for Braymer is junior tail-back/Middle linebacker Reid Brooke, carrying the ball 17 times for 62 yards. Defensively, Reid recorded 7 tackles including a crushing hit on junior quarterback Keagan Prather. Reid had a solid week and that's what they need from the junior tail-back/Middle linebacker. In other stats; passing: John Haley threw 8 times with 3 completions and 42 yards. Rushing/Receiving: Trent Utt carried 5 times for 25 yards; Utt also had a reception for 33 yards, the Bobcats longest offensive play of the day. Trevor Corbin carried 8 times for 17 yards and John Haley carried 17 times for 9 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball, Reid Brooke was the leading tackler followed by Issac Pollard with 5 tackles including a sack, Trevor Corbin recorded 5 tackles followed by Jared Clevenger with 4, and James Schreier with 2 including a sack. Caden Shonk, Trent Utt, Dylan Adkison, John Haley, Blake Peters, Dalton Owen, and Brandon Taylor all had 1.
