

Braymer vs. Salisbury

Trevor Corbin and John Haley had 4 each, followed by James Schreier and Caden Shonk with 3. Dalton Owen had 2 tackles with 1 sack, Austin Cockrell with 1 sack, followed Jared Clevenger and Clayton Brown with 1 tackle.

This Friday September 11th your Braymer Bobcats will travel to Hamilton to face the Hamilton Hornets. Hamilton is 2-0 and ranked 2nd in the state behind the state champion Orrick Bearcats.
