

## **BRAYMER CELEBRATES COURTWARMING**

The Braymer Bobcats hosted the Hardin Central Bulldogs for their rescheduled Courtwarming on Friday night, and went to the dance afterwards with a 64-32 victory in hand. The original Courtwarming against Norborne was cancelled the previous Friday night due to weather. It was the third game this season lost to snow or ice. At this time there is no room on the schedule to make these games up.

Hardin got off to a good start and led at the end of the first quarter by a 10-8 margin, but the Bobcats finally got untracked early in the second frame and took control of the game. Nate Owen came off the bench to contribute 5 points while Caden Shonk had 3 points and 3 rebounds. Dylan Adkison pulled down 5 rebounds and scored 2. Trent Utt, battling the flu bug, handed out 5 assists and scored 2 points. Jesse Utt did not score but had a nice floor game as a reserve with 4 assists and 3 steals.

The win moves Braymer's season record to 16-3. Next week is a big one for the Bobcats with home games against state ranked Meadville and Tina-Avalon and a finale on the road against the highly ranked Class 2 Wellington-Napolean Tigers.
