

BRAYMER TOPS TINA-AVALON

The Braymer Bobcats host the Tina-Avalon Dragons Thursday night for their Senior Night on the last game of the season and came away with a hard fought 72-58 victory.

Braymer jumped out front on the strength of a 25 point offensive outburst in the first quarter but could not hold TA's offense in check. Behind the 1-2 scoring punch of Logan Holmer and Zach Grossman, the Dragons kept the game close until the 4th quarter when the Bobcats held the to 10 points.

Four seniors from Braymer scored in double figures and another came up only 2 points short.

James Schreier led the Bobcats with 19 points and pulled down 5 rebounds. Clayton Brown continued his fine performances with a double-double of 18 points and 13 rebounds to go along with a pair of blocked shots. John Haley added 17 points and Caden Shonk came off the bench to have his best game of the season with 10 points and 4 assists. Trent Utt played a great all-around game with 8 points, 7 assists and 5 steals. Dylan Adkison continued to be the defensive stopper he has been all year and Brett Willis added several minutes of quality playing time off the bench. Brandon Taylor, sophomore post player hauled down 5 rebounds and scored a point in limited time.

The win pushes Braymer's season record to 17-4 with their only remaining game being a Friday night matchup with #2 state ranked Class 2 Wellington-Napolean.
