John Haley carried the ball 12 times for 47 yards, and Reid Brooke carried 7 times for 25 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball Trevor Corbin lead with 7 tackles followed by Issac Pollard and Dylan Adkison with 6 tackles. John Haley with 5 followed by Caden Shonk, Jared Clevenger, and Dalton Owen with 3. Tackles weren't dominated by an individual but spread through-out the defense.
