


Braymer C-4 One-to-One

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I would like to first thank you for such a great start to the school year. It has been an amazing first couple of months and I have no doubt that is due in large-part to the incredible support our students receive at home in both prioritizing academics and expectations for behavior. I can't say enough how great I think our student body and staff are.

I'm writing to let you know about a new initiative we're launching at the JH/HS called One-to-One (1:1). 1:1 is an educational program that ensures access to technology by providing each student with a technology device. At Braymer we will accomplish this by assigning and "checking-out" and "checking-in" devices to students daily. Students will be assigned the same device every day, but devices will remain at school and will not be taken home by the student. The purpose of this program is to maximize the access to information of our students and teachers in the classroom and allow our students to build a skill set in technology use that will serve them well after they leave Braymer High School.
