The first date to file for the April 4, 2023, School Board Election is December 6, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. The last date to file is December 27, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Other filing times are during the regular business hours of 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Individuals wishing to file between December 17, 2022 through December 27, 2022, may contact Cindy Peters at 660-973-1516 to make arrangements while the office is closed for the holidays.

Board candidates must be citizens of the United States and resident taxpayers of the District, they must reside in the state of Missouri for one year preceding the election and be at least 24 years of age. No person qualifies as a candidate who has been convicted of, found guilty or pled guilty to a felony under the laws of this state. All candidates must complete a Personal Financial Disclosure Statement.

All newly elected Board of Education members shall obtain 16 hours of required training during their first year of service.

Three, three year terms will be filled. The terms of Vickie Davidson, Rachel Hunt and Darin Kincaid will expire in April 2023.
